

VILLAGE OF LOCKLAND, OHIO
ORDINANCE # 2026 - 33

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE RETENTION OF
PATRICK DRESSING AS MAYOR'S COURT MAGISTRATE
OF THE VILLAGE, AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, It is necessary for the Village of Lockland to appoint a Magistrate to Mayor's Court; and

WHEREAS, Patrick Dressing has been retained to serve as Lockland's Mayor's Court Magistrate; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Lockland, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION I Patrick Dressing is retained and appointed to provide service as Magistrate in Lockland Mayor's Court at a rate of \$500 per session of court.


SECTION II Magistrate Dressing shall be designated as a part-time employee for receipt of benefits, OPERS and other relevant purposes.

SECTION III The rates and appointments contained herein shall be for calendar year 2026, but shall continue until such time that they are adjusted by Council ordinance, to the extent provided by statute.


SECTION IV Lockland, or the Magistrate named in this Ordinance, may terminate the relationship provided for herein upon thirty (30) days' written notice.

SECTION V This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Lockland and shall, therefore, become effective immediately. The reason for said emergency is the immediate necessity for the Village to conduct Mayor's Court with a Magistrate available in 2026.
